The Projects:

B Creative is an Arts Activism project for young women aged 16-25, led by inspiring female artists, working with exceptional arts companies. Young women take part in a mix of dance, poetry, photography, music and more, making and sharing work about issues that matter to young women today.

The Young Creatives will co-produce these projects with All Change and will support children, young people and families to take part and benefit from the opportunities they offer.

These paid roles will begin in **July 2022**.

The roles are offered on a sessional basis, **paid at London Living Wage - £11.05 per hour**.

Salary	£11.05 p/h [London Living Wage] or voluntary [see below*]
Location	All Change and various arts/community venues in Islington**
Hours	The Young Creative role is offered on a part-time sessional basis, up to a maximum of 16 hours per week. Dates and hours of work will be as agreed with All Change's Programme Producer. The hours of work may be irregular and some travel in and around Islington and/or London may be involved. Due to the nature of work it may not be possible to specify all dates and hours of work before the start of the project and some flexibility is requested. The location of your work may vary, depending on the project. It is likely, however, that the majority of your work will be at project community venues within Islington.
Availability	Availability on weekdays during August 2022 is essential. Availability on some Saturdays and evenings is desirable.

JOB DESCRIPTION

As a Young Creative, your role you will include:

 - Visiting and talking to youth projects in Islington
 - Visiting and talking to community groups in Islington
 - Talking to Islington Youth Councillors
 - Visiting and talking to young people at events
- Supporting children, young people and families to get involved in the programme and workshop activities, especially ensuring that children and young people who might not usually get the opportunity to be involved have the chance to.
- Contributing towards the evaluation of the projects
- Being a positive representative for young people and ensuring that young people's voices are heard throughout the planning and delivery of the projects

You will receive training and mentoring from All Change to support you to deliver your role.
